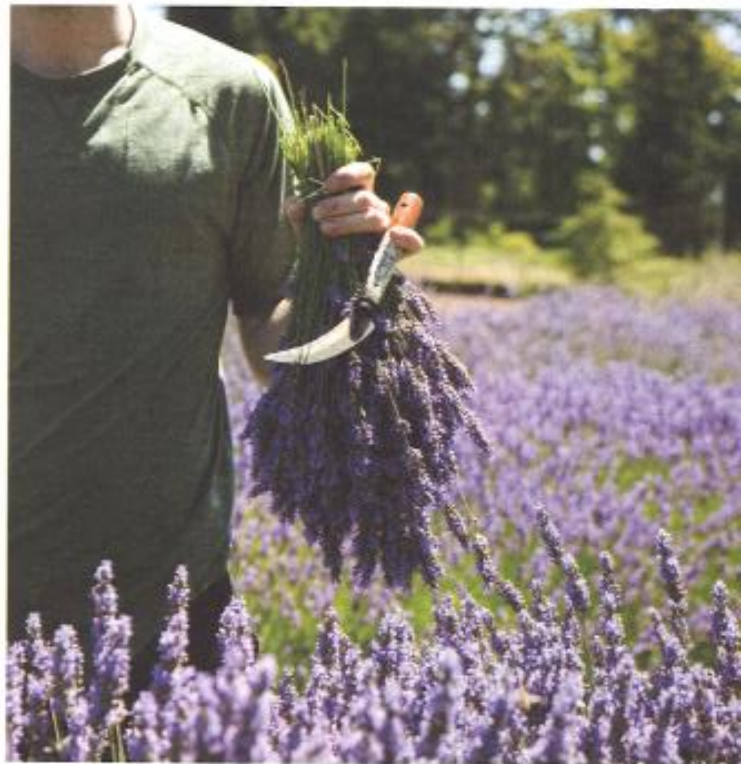
SAUSAGE & CIDERFEST
